# **PANAGEANEWS**

This month we begin in the increasingly volatile East, long thought to be under the complete dominion of Chaos....

On the Crystal Plains outside the Human city of Narga Thum, Fedaykin (Lawful Terminator Humans) destroyed Sea Dogs Of Panagea (Shhvoon worshipping SWARM Humans). Three weeks later Howling Winds (Chaotic Kodan Raman Gnolls) destroyed the fleeing Legion Of The Green (Lawful AIM Elves).

In the Black Mountains outside the Lizaran city of Flea Bite, Trekkers (Lawful Terminator Humans) and Bloodguard (Lawful Terminator Humans) teamed up to destroy Maelstrom (Shhvoon worshipping SWARM Giants). Three weeks later Trekkers launched a surprise assault on Flea Bite (Lo-kee worshipping CSA Lizara) itself only to be repulsed with heavy losses. At the Orc city of Iron Keep, Mariana (Lawful Terminator Humans) defeated the fleeing 37th Kodan Battalion (Chaotic Kodan Raman Orcs). At about the same time Brraalt's Brigade (Chaotic Kodan Raman Gnolls) and Silent Covenant (Chaotic Kodan Raman Gnolls) teamed up to defeat the fleeing Jackson Hole (Humans). At the Orc city of Grimhold, RDF (Chaotic Kodan Raman Gnolls) defeated the fleeing Andar's Own (Humans).

Moving to the Central Region, on the Isle Of Medes outside the Gnoll city of Peladon, Smasher (Lawful Terminator Humans) lived up to its name and destroyed Heat Seekers (Chaotic LOOT Orcs). At about the same time Clan Thaxton (Lawful Terminator Humans) defeated the fleeing Chain (Chaotic Kodan Raman Orcs). Three weeks later Clan Thaxton once again hit Chain with similar results.

On the island of Mycenea, Orca (Lawful Terminator Humans) defeated a retreating Toad's Sons (Shhvoon worshipping Lizara) in a close battle. Three weeks later Orca struck again, this time with the support of Revenge (Lawful Terminator Humans) and defeated Toad Lords (Shhvoon worshipping Lizara). The next day Plains Drifters (Lawful Terminator Humans) destroyed the remnants of the hapless Toad Lords.

Moving to the West, in the region known as Mireland outside the Lizaran city of Hesh T'eerakk, Swampwalkers (Lo-kee worshipping Lizara), Snayks (Lo-kee worshipping Lizara), and Grave Robbers (Trimorph worshipping CSA Giants) teamed up to defeat the fleeing Movallens (Lawful Terminator Humans).

In the Tarakeen Forest outside the Human city of Ravenwood, Lions Of The North (Wicca worshipping Humans) defeated the fleeing Leftovers (Lawful AIM Giants). At about the same time and 150 miles away, Shadowcat Rangers (Wicca worshipping Humans) destroyed Third Legion (Lawful Humans).

In the Vaeld Mountains outside the Dwarven city of Thraegens Deep, Dragonright (Lo-kee worshipping CSA Lizara) defeated the retreating Smashers (Lawful AIM Giants) in a close battle.

On the Agerian Plain outside the Goblin city of Isengak, Fangs Of The Wolf (Lawful HARM Gnolls) smashed the Fareye Flyers (Chaotic ACE Gnolls). Two weeks later Fangs Of The Wolf attacked again, this time defeating Rabid Hounds (Cosmic Balance worshipping Gnolls) in a hard fought battle.

In the region known as Malundia, Tonatiuh's Torch (Lawful Kobolds) destroyed Xeeqa Swarm (Miiya worshipping Xaati). Meanwhile, one hundred miles away at the Kobold city of Ez'zak, Ez'zak Pochteca (Lawful Kobolds) destroyed Skali's Raiders (Humans).

Soon thereafter Ratt Skinners ambushed and defeated Rohirrim (Lawful Centaurs of the Crystalian Warriors). Two weeks later Gongylus Gongyloids (Ya-zii worshipping Xorg) destroyed the remnants of Truth And Light while Foresters destroyed the remnants of Rohirrim. At the Human city of Novograd, Ziira Swarm (Miiya worshipping Xaati) defeated Ashanti (Humans) in a close battle.
